INCREDIBLE

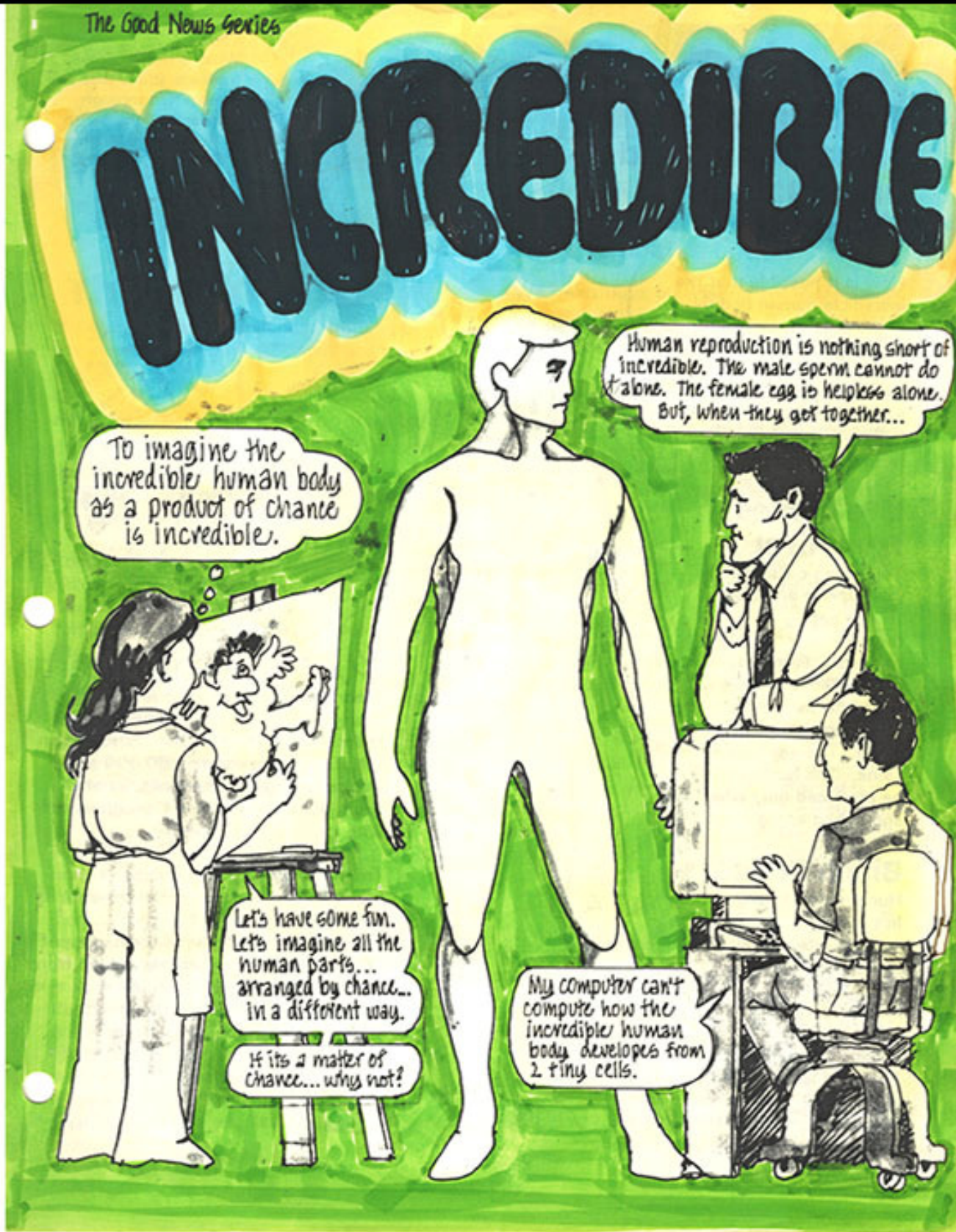
To imagine the incredible human body as a product of chance is incredible.

Birth Process

A baby frog does not look like a frog, and is not called a frog. Is it a frog? Some critters are hatched from eggs. The birth process stretches the imagination.

The ear is extremely well designed. The inner ear is so delicate that if any part is missing, hearing is impossible.

What is heard comes from vibrations that are transmitted through the parts of the ear to the brain.

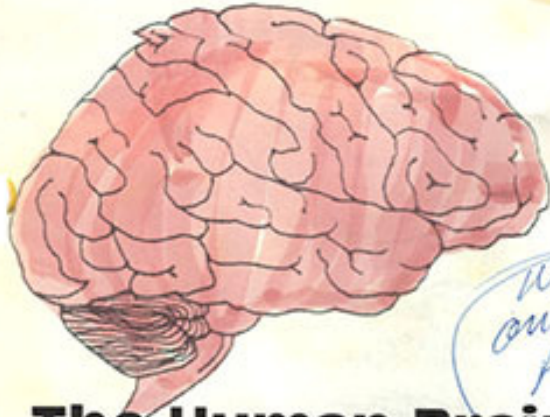


The human heart

A normal heart beats about 70 times every minute and pumps about 1,800 gallons of blood every day. The human body has approximately 60,000 miles of blood vessels. The heart is not large, but it pumps blood through vessels with remarkable efficiency.

The heart is really two pumps in one. Blood from the lungs (full of oxygen) is pumped to all parts of the body... through the right part of the heart. At the same time oxygen-poor blood from all parts of the body is circulated through the left part of the heart... back through the lungs for refueling.

Which came first...the blood, heart Or blood vessels?



The Human Brain

It weighs about three pounds. Nothing of any size can match its efficiency and flexibility.

At times the brain is compared to a computer. There is no comparison. It is like comparing the primitive carvings in a cave wall to the math that can be done on the finest calculator.

Computers do not function without what is called Linear Sequential Programs. The brain responds many times faster than any computer and has the ability to drastically alter its own program.

Both the brain and the computer operate on electrical impulses. A computer processes information one step at a time...with lightning quickness. The brain processes millions of pieces of information at the same time...with undescrivable speed.

The brain controls every function of the body, keeping all the trillions of cells working in incredible harmony. Is it possible ^{this} incredibly complex organ happened by chance? If so, which came first the brain or the body it controls. Without the body there is no need for the brain. Without the brain there could be no body as we know it.

The evidence says the brain and body had to come into existence at the same time.

That sounds strangely like creation!

What does it all mean?

What is the great challenge when explaining the incredible human body?

We must have an answer for these facts.

IT IS A FACT...Human life comes from human life.

IT IS A FACT...Every human characteristic is contained in two tiny cells that combine at conception.

IT IS A FACT...The brain controls the whole body. Which came first...the brain or the body?

IT IS A FACT...Without the regular work of the heart, the body cannot live. Without the heart the brain cannot function. Without the brain the heart cannot function.

IT IS A FACT...The human ear is so well designed that if one tiny part is missing it will not function.

IT IS A FACT...Without blood and blood vessels the heart would be worthless. Without the heart the blood and vessels would be worthless. Without the action of the heart and blood vessels there would be no oxygen and all the vital organs would quickly die...and nothing would work.

IT IS A FACT...We have not considered the dozens of organs that are vital for life. Without the liver (the human body bank and filter system) the body would quickly die of poisoning. Without the special composition of the blood, the body would not last long. Without the incredible eye, we could not see the beauty around us.
