

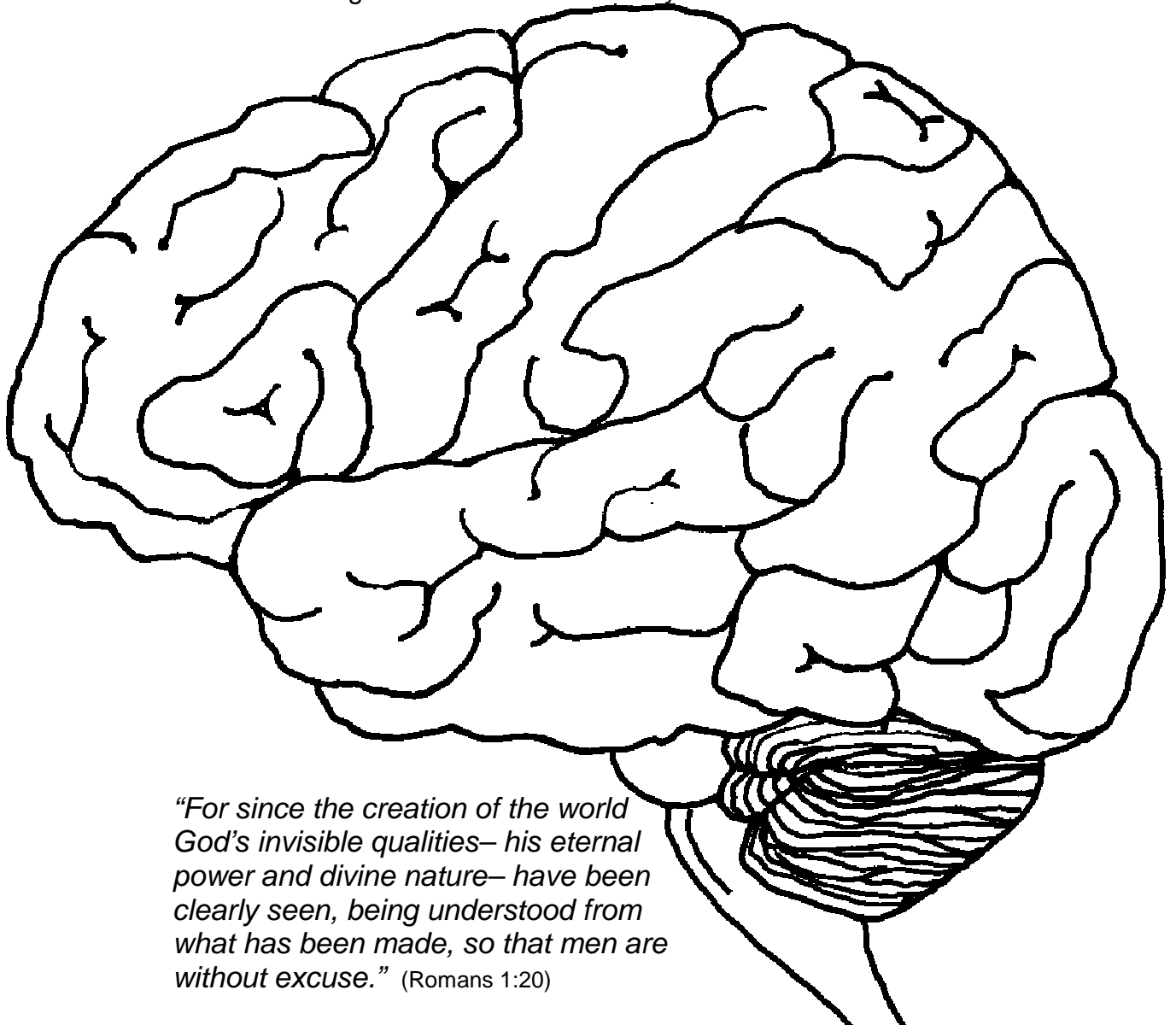
# Three Pounds of Power
